

THE WAY of Ignorance


In the apparently unpleasant process of birth, an infant has the feeling that the whole purpose of living is to regain the non-disturbed state from which it was expelled, and who could blame it! This feeling becomes a decision that is active from then on, unless it is one day acknowledged, reevaluated, and a new decision about thr

purpose of living is made in its place.

As he grows, he makes more decisions to try to help in his quest for non-disturbance. They are understandable for a child, and in the beginning some of them even work. He complains and demands and his needs and wants are most often met. One day he realizes that pleasing Mama can better work to get his way, but he really wants to complain. Conflict has been established. Later he is told to obey or else, and depends on others and their ideas to be responsible for him. Conflict takes its toll and the child feels if he would change he'd be non-disturbed. That doesn't work and he begins to blame everyone and everything else for his misery.

This internal conflict makes life a battleground to him, he lives in eternal warfare, both inside and around him, because everyone else is in the same predicament. We all know that war leads to death and destruction, yet those ignorant of their purpose of living will continue to struggle on this battlefield until finally death brings them non-disturbance. Maybe.

THE WAY of Intelligence

Intelligent people have the awareness to know what they are, spirit having a human experience; where they are, in the physical real; what's going on, resistance to initiative, and what they can do.

The awareness function of their invisible self evaluates impressions both internal and external, evaluating them according to a single-minded purpose of living, and the invisible spirit within responds accordingly to this evaluation through the physical body.

The intelligent person refuses to live in conflict. If his single-minded purpose is intact, he will be consciously acting every moment. When lapses occur and conflict ensues, he will immediately recognize that he has walked into a minefield and stop, reconsider, refuse to make war, refuse to let warfare rage within him. He knows that conflict is a warning signal that he fell asleep on the job and he will shake himself awake. If overwhelmed by circumstances, he still refuses to indulge in conflict, he gets quiet and mindful. He does not engage in endless pro-and con- debates about what to do, he doesn't look for blame.

THE WAY of Intelligence is for adults only. If THE WAY of Intelligence were used to determine anyone's adult status, we would find, as a wise old man of my acquaintance used to say, that "for the most part, the world is populated by infants with grown bodies and technical educations."

### The Four Forces

I was chatting with my favorite engineer the other day about the asteroid that's apparently hurtling toward Earth and without intervention would crash in a hundred years or so and set us back to the stone age at best. Despite some of the fear-mongering press, I am not the least bit concerned--I know the engineers will fix it. The only thing left to do is decide how much we're willing to pay for the fix.

I've been around engineers since I was a child, and several have patiently explained the principles to me, I have a fair working knowledge of what they do. It wasn't until I understood the principles of THE WAY of Intelligence, though, that I realized exactly what makes engineers so unfailingly accurate—they understand Second Force perfectly, they don't hate it, and are not stupid enough to think they could avoid it. (And probably wouldn't think engineering any fun if they could.) They work with it, every day. They accommodate it, find ways to pay it, they dance with it. There's not a machine in our lives that wasn't designed by someone who is completely comfortable with Second Force, at least as it applies to the mechanical world. Now if they, or anyone, understood that emotions are mechanical, and that we live in a realm where Second Force is present in every phenomenon, there'd be a whole lot more peace of mind and a lot less bellyaching.

When one thinks of the huge influence of machines in our lives, one has to marvel that everyone doesn't have the acceptance of Second Force that engineering demands. It's THE WAY it is-no one could possibly be considered an intelligent adult who doesn't recognize, by observation, and gracefully accept Second Force, understanding that there's no such thing as merely "cause and effect", but are four forces.

INITIATIVE = Making up the mind toward an aim

RESISTANCE = Opposition to the Initiative

FORM = Evidence that Initiative and Resistance were allowed to work together

RESULT = The outcome of the above



# The Four Dual Basic Urges

The Four Dual Basic Urges are a fundamental part of the human experience. Observation of infants and children demonstrates that the 4DBUs are their "prime mover" or motivation for nearly everything--the whole purpose of living. A grown body in itself does not eliminate this erroneous purpose. Until intelligence reevaluates this purpose, one cannot truly be called an adult, no matter the age. The 4DBUs are not "bad" or "good"--only children see it that way. They just "are," but certainly are not the whole purpose of living.

The Third System

There are three convenient stages of human growth: infancy, adolescence and adulthood, which provide us with an adequate comparison standard for three stages of community development.

In the first, visible crudity and destructivity is evident. This is childhood, equivalent to the conquest of territory in

the community's life.

The second is characterized by intense emotion, mental activity and insistence upon objectives. Its equivalent is the "derivative baronial" phase. Instead of conquering national territories, its spread is in domination of the brain (propaganda and publicity) and in energy concentration--commercial and industrial empires.

Communities of all social, political and economic labels operate these systems.

The third type, which is the final phase, and the most effective and constructive, is an organization which can contribute in so many fields that it cannot be singled out as an enemy, or even as a friend, for its members come from every section of every community. By providing positive and demonstrable gains in such diverse fields as literature, commerce, art, science, psychology and human thought and social relations, it penetrates through-

out the interstices of the existing relatively crude systems.

In order to do this, such an entity must be directed by people who understand it as well as the baron understands war, or the tycoon understands business. There are not many such men and women, but they already exist.

This development has been fore-shadowed by the attempts of nations, companies and systems to offer their members a wide variety of advantages. But they have all failed because they cannot control their people (control is the wrong method, but they depend upon it) and because they have not been able to supply the creative quota of varied developments which alone could make their organism viable in the new system.

So they have to be content with the new peasantry. Remember: a peasantry is not a community of impoverished people ruled by rich ones. A peasantry is a community, national or international, which is "owned": which has its beliefs engineered by propaganda, and its material activities and its diversions provided for it to someone's gain.
